## ST MARTIN'S HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

St Martin-in-the-Fields High School is a Church of England school which is part of the wider Christian community. The school benefits from strong links with its founders St Martin-in-the-Fields Church, the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge and also from the Southwark Diocesan Board of Education.

As set out in the school aims, Christian values are at the heart of all we do. At St Martin's, we believe that if our students are to have full benefit from our excellent facilities and high quality teaching then a successful partnership between the school, the Church, parents and pupils is of paramount importance.

The following statement supports this partnership in the interests of our children.

### TOGETHER WE WILL

- Support the values of the school.
- Promote the highest standards of work.
- Promote the highest standards of behaviour.
- Promote the highest standard of dress.

### AS A SCHOOL WE WILL

- Provide a balanced and appropriate curriculum.
- Provide a caring and nurturing environment.
- Provide appropriate work for pupils of all ages and abilities which help them progress.
- Establish a code of conduct which insists upon the highest standards of behaviour and promotes dignity, self worth and respect.
- Provide effective means of communication between school and home.
- Monitor our pupils' progress and send regular reports home.
- Notify parents of any concerns we have relating to their daughters' progress or conduct.
- Provide advice and guidance over the pupils' work.
- Provide and mark homework in accordance with the school's Homework Policy.
- Work with your daughter to set meaningful targets to aid her progress.

### AS A PARENT/GUARDIAN I WILL

- Let the school know about any concerns about my daughter.
- Regularly attend parents meetings to review my daughter's progress.
- Support the school's rules and expectations set out in the code of conduct.
- Ensure that my daughter attends school regularly, on time and with everything she needs.
- Contact the school on the first day of any absence.
- Ensure that my daughter completes and returns homework on time.
- Support the Christian ethos & encourage my daughter to take full part in the life of a church school.
- Ensure that my daughter wears correct school uniform every day.
- Avoid taking my daughter on holiday during school time, unless in an emergency. In this case I will notify the Head Teacher of my intentions immediately.
- Avoid making non-urgent medical or dental appointments in school time.
- Ensure that my daughter looks after and returns any property loaned to her from the school.

### AS A STUDENT I WILL

- Work to the best of my ability.
- Follow the school's code of behaviour.
- Complete my homework and hand it in at the right time.
- Attend the school every day unless I am ill.
- Come to school on time.
- Wear my correct uniform.
- Do all I can to keep the school tidy and take care of equipment.
- Treat everyone with respect.
- Follow the school's Anti-bullying Charter.
- Leave my mobile phone at home or hand it in at reception in the morning.
