DRESS CODE AND EXPECTATIONS

- SCHOOL BLAZER** to be worn at all times
- SKIRT** plain dark brown, in plain material (Polyester/Viscose only)
- BLOUSE** plain beige (long or short sleeve)
- JUMPER** for girls in Years 7 & 8 the school jumper is brown with a red neck stripe; for girls in Years 9 - 11 the school jumper is red with a brown neck stripe.
- SUMMER DRESS** compulsory for Years 7 and 8
- SHOES** brown or black leather with low heels NOT trainers, canvas or material shoes, trainer-type footwear or boots
- SOCKS** white, dark brown or black (plain)
- TIGHTS** beige, dark brown or black (plain)
- COAT** plain, dark brown, beige, red or black outdoor coat; no denim.
- HEADGEAR** hats, etc. should be worn only in inclement weather on the way to and from school; these should be in the school colours; baseball caps, ski caps are not appropriate.

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- PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM** plain red games shirt with collar
brown wrap-over games skirt
school shorts-black (for gymnastics/athletics)
sports trainers (white)
socks (white)
a supportive bra or sports bra is recommended
school tracksuit (Black with red stripes -(Wolfe & Scott)
PE bag for storing these items

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- RELIGIOUS DRESS** For Muslim girls the following may be worn: headscarf in black, red or beige (plain material); ankle length brown skirt; black leggings under PE skirt; an adapted summer dress.

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- OPTIONAL UNIFORM** Plain school scarf in school colours
accessories (e.g. hair bands/ribbons) - these must be in the school colours or brown, red beige or black, no beads or other hair accessory
in cold weather a white or cream T shirt may be worn underneath the blouse, but this should not be visible

PLEASE NOTE	The school cannot take responsibility for loss of money. It is expected that money is kept in a purse on the person at all times, or handed to student services for safe keeping. A neck purse or purse belt is recommended. Girls should not bring large sums of money to school. If a student comes to school incorrectly dressed, the school reserves the right to send her home to change immediately.
MOBILE PHONES	Mobile phones should be switched off at all times whilst in school or handed into student services. We will not take responsibility for mobiles or other electronic equipment if it is brought into school.
JEWELLERY	Jewellery is not permitted except for: one pair of small studs, one in each ear a small crucifix worn under the blouse
HAIR	Hair/reasonable length extensions should be the colour of your natural hair colour. Accessories (e.g. hair bands/ribbons) - these must be in the school colours or brown, red beige or black, no beads or other hair accessory.

Please note that the following are NOT permitted:

- Trainers
- Canvas shoes
- Material shoes
- Trainer-type footwear
- Leisure shoes
- Decorations of any kind on shoes
- Boots
- Sandals
- Patterned headscarves
- Patterned trainers or Leisure shoes for PE
- Elaborate headbands or headwear not in school colours
- Denim coats/jackets
- Leather coats/jackets
- Hoodies or similar, must not be worn or brought into school
- Baseball caps
- Ski hats

Students will be directed to remove the following:

- Make up
- Nail varnish
- False nails
- False eye lashes
- Non-prescription contact lenses

Piercing and Tattoos

These are not permitted and students will be asked to remove piercings

- Nose studs
- Other facial piercings
- Body piercing
- Tattoos, temporary or otherwise
