## Bursaries and rewards

### St Martin's Trust

All students can apply for a bursary in Y12 and Y13 for each year of their studies, upon the agreement that they meet entry requirements. An additional £500 bursary is offered to one student upon completion of their studies at sixth form and acceptance of university offer or higher-level apprenticeship.

### Rewards Scheme

### Study Skills

A unique range of study skills/revision classes and workshops that aim to bridge the gap between KS4 & KS5 learning, delivered by external experts.
