Who are the members?

The school is an academy and therefore a charitable company ('the company'). It is also known as an Academy Trust. It currently has three 'members' appointed under Article 12 of the [Articles](#).

What is their remit?

Members are the owners of the company (but with liability limited to £10) and their main role is to ensure that the company performs its functions in accordance with its charitable objects. They therefore do not have control of the day to day running of the company but do appoint most of the governors (also known as directors) upon nomination by others. Members may also be directors.
