Dear Year 10 Families

I hope you have looked through the Year 10 timetable that I sent out yesterday and have had a chance to talk to your daughter about what to expect next week. Your daughter will have remote livestream lessons with all her subject teachers in line with the timetable. Some students will have a combination of remote and face to face learning with their teachers in school.

A reminder that the onsite face to face provision is for students studying GCSE Art and Music and students who do not have access to the internet. If you have not been contacted by a member of staff, **please do not** send your daughter to school. However, please contact us if you have not heard from us and think your daughter is in one of these categories and should be invited into school.

We have carried out a thorough risk assessment ahead of this phased reopening. This is to ensure that we put in place comprehensive control measures to limit the risk to staff and students. The risk assessment has been reviewed by staff, governors and unions. You will find a copy of the risk assessment in the home learning section on our website or you can access it <u>here.</u>

It is important that you read this, and especially important should your daughter be coming into school next week. Thank you for your patience and support. I do hope that even though I send out so many letters and documents, you feel we are keeping you updated with everything that is going on in school and that we are working tirelessly to support your daughter with her studies at this difficult time.

We are really looking forward to seeing some of the girls with us next week. I hope that you will be reassured when you read the risk assessment and all our documentation that we are doing everything we possibly can to maintain a safe environment, as the safety and wellbeing of our school community is paramount.
