Dear Year 12 Families

We hope you have looked through the Year 12 timetable that was sent to you on Thursday 11 June and have had a chance to talk to your child about what to expect this week. Your child will have remote livestream lessons with all their subject teachers in line with the timetable.

A reminder that the onsite face to face provision is for sixth form students who do not have access to the internet. If you have not been contacted by a member of staff, **please do not** send your child to school. However, please contact us if you have not heard from us and think your child is in one of these categories and should be invited into school.

We have carried out a thorough risk assessment ahead of this phased reopening. This is to ensure that we put in place comprehensive control measures to limit the risk to staff and students.
