Monday 22 June 2020

A warm welcome to St Martin's. It gives me great pleasure to welcome you and your daughter to our wonderful school. Apologies for such a long letter, but please read it to the end.

We are very much looking forward to meeting you and your daughter when she starts with us in September. Many would have returned to primary school last week and enjoyed seeing their friends again. Rest assured, your daughter will make lots of new friends when she starts at St Martin's and we will do everything possible to help your daughter settle happily into secondary school.

Due to the current situation we are unable to invite you to visit us in person, so our planned programme has moved online. We very much look forward to you joining us for these transition events and want to let you know that we are here to support you and your family as this transfer from primary to secondary takes place.

I invite you to visit our school website and our home learning section. You will see some fabulous examples of learning in our weekly Simply the Best bulletin and I would also like to refer you to our school risk assessment section where you will find two documents, one that is visual, that will help to reassure you of all the control measures we have in place to keep everyone in St Martin's safe and well. There is also a dedicated page on our website for our new Year 7 students in the Admissions section under "Welcome to Year 7".

We will have a range of 'Starting Secondary School' documentation that you will need to complete. All of these have been enclosed with this letter. Please return them to school either by post or in person by **Friday 10th July**. We will also need a copy of your daughter's birth certificate or passport which she should bring with her on her first day in school. Please see the checklist enclosed.

Your Journey Begins - Expectations and Induction - Our first event for you and your daughters is on Monday 29 June at 6.00pm and will take place online using Google Meet. Ordinarily, we would invite our new students into school the next day for a Year 6 Induction day but as we are not able to do this in the current circumstances we are moving this event online too. The Year 6 induction will now take place virtually on Tuesday 30 June from 10am to 11:30am also via Google Meet.

In addition, this year we are inviting new parents to a **virtual coffee morning/afternoon** which will provide a less formal format where you will be able to meet key members of staff and ask any questions that you may have. We have two time slots available for this, **Thursday 2 July at 2pm** and **Tuesday 7 July at 10am** and we hope that you will be able to join us for one of these.

Uniform - You will find enclosed information about our school uniform, where to purchase, how to purchase and how much items cost. Our uniform supplier, School Uniform Direct, will attend our event on 1 July and you will be able to get more information about the special offers from the



representative who will be able to answer all your questions. We have a range of nearly new uniform items which can be purchased direct from the school.

We believe our 'Your Journey Begins' programme will give your daughter a solid grounding in ensuring she is as comfortable as possible as she embarks on this new phase of her education. We are extremely proud of how our existing students welcome all our new Year 7s into our community and how well and quickly they settle to be happy and confident St Martin's Girls! Enclosed with this letter is a booklet of messages from our current Year 7 students welcoming your daughter to St Martin's and sharing advice about the transition process.

I wish I could end this letter by giving you the date that your daughter will be starting with us in September, but unfortunately I am unable to do this at the moment. All I can say is that we hope it will be at the beginning of September. As soon as the government has given us more directives and guidance on opening schools more widely than we currently are, I will let you know.

In the meantime, please do not hesitate to contact us, school is open for phone calls and urgent visits, by appointment only. We are here to help and support in any way we can, and together, as a school community we will get through these unprecedented and uncertain times and emerge stronger as a result.
