Dear Families

I hope you are keeping safe and well. I am writing to let you know that it is half term next week. Teachers will not be posting any new work into the google classrooms. This will be a time for your daughter to consolidate her learning and for all of us to have a rest from the intensity of this new way of learning and teaching. We will resume again on Monday 1 June 2020.

Recent government guidance confirmed that key stage 3 students (those in Year 7 to 9) will not return to school until September at the earliest. The plans for Year 10 and Year 12 are still being considered. Paramount to any return is the safety and wellbeing of staff, students and families especially for those groups within our wider school community who have been hardest hit by the virus.
