This letter is about two things: The Government Scheme for additional data access for disadvantaged students and the Government Mass Covid-19 Testing Programme in schools.

## **DfE Children's Mobile Data Scheme**

The government has released a limited number of packages increasing data allowances on mobile devices to support disadvantaged children. The government has outlined that schools can request help to increase mobile data allowances for children and young people who: do not have fixed broadband at home; cannot afford additional data for their devices to access educational resources; are experiencing disruption to their face-to-face education.

## **Government Mass Covid-19 Testing Programme in Schools**

We have set up a section on our website called <u>COVID-19 testing</u>. In this section you will find information and letters about the testing programme in St Martin's.

As you know the Government wanted all schools to begin testing from the week beginning 4 January. As a National Lockdown was announced on 5 January, we are no longer able to do this. Our plan is to begin mass testing when we return to school. In the meantime, with consent, we will test staff and students who are in school for onsite learning during the period of lockdown.
