END OF FREE BUS TRAVEL IN LONDON FOR 18'S DELAYED

Dear Families

You will remember that I wrote to you about the government's plans to suspend free bus travel in London for 11 to 17 year olds due to begin after October half term.

It is shameful to think that this would happen, and thankfully the move to suspend has now been delayed until the spring 2021 for logistical reasons. This will also give more time for the London Mayor and the 'Don't Zap the Zip' campaign to continue putting pressure on the government to enable young people to continue to benefit from free travel.
